Hunting show postponed to October amidst third wave concerns

The agreement reached between SAPS and HuntEx on 20 May 2021 regarding Covid 19 restrictions, has been greeted with much satisfaction and joy by all concerned. Small businesses that have been prevented from selling their goods on these platforms for more than a year, can now look forward to doing business again.

The agreement, which has been made an order of the High Court, allows HuntEx to do business like any shopping centre, and gave hope to the entire exhibition industry that has been forced into irrational dormancy.

However, the organisers have been requested by a substantial number of exhibitors to take into consideration their concerns about the increase in coronavirus cases in Gauteng and elsewhere.

“After discussing it with many exhibitors and other stakeholders, we have agreed not to stage HuntEx2021 in June but to postpone it to 1-3 October 2021. This decision allows the majority of exhibitors to participate, as the third wave fears will hopefully be a thing of the past,” said Adriaan Woudstra, organiser of HuntEx.

Jagskou uitgestel tot Oktober weens kommer oor derde vlag Covid-infeksies

Die ooreenkoms wat die SAPD en HuntEx op 20 Mei oor die Covid-10-inperkings bereik het, is met groot verligting en vreugde deur betrokkenes in die bedryf verwelkom. Klein sake-ondernemings wat vir meer as 'n jaar nie hulle produkte kon verkoop nie, sien baie uit daarna om weer sake te kan doen.

Die ooreenkoms wat as 'n hofbeslissing deur die Hooggeregshof uitgereik is, gee HuntEx toestemming om op dieselfde grondslag as enige winkelsentrum sake te doen. Dit gee ook hoop aan die hele uitstalbedryf wat tot 'n irrasionele stilstand gedwing is.

Intussen het talle uitstallers hulle kommer uitgespreek oor die toename in coronavirusgevalle in Gauteng en elders, en die organiseerder versoek om die skoudatum te heroorweeg.

“Ons het die omstandighede met baie van ons uitstallers en ander rolspelers bespreek, en ooreengekom om HuntEx 2021 wat in Junie sou plaasvind, vir eers uit te stel tot 1-3 Oktober 2021. Hierdie besluit sal die meerderheid uitstallers toelaat om deel te neem aangesien kommer oor die derde vlag Covid-gevalle teen daardie tyd hopelik oorgewai het,” sê Adriaan Woudstra, HuntEx-organiseerder.
